3. Venue

Address: **105 Stadium - Lungomare Canepa, 155 - 16149 Genova Sampierdarena (GE).**

105 Stadium which officially opened in October 2003, is a fine example of how to convert an industrial building into a multifunctional space. The original 1970 exterior of the former Ansaldo factory has been retained, but inside the building has been completely renovated, using the latest insulation and sound proofing systems, to remove architectural barriers and create a series of flexible, modular spaces. The main arena covers 1,800 sqm has a capacity of 5,000 people and was designed to deliver the utmost in exhibition flexibility, guaranteeing excellent visibility in a striking setting. Mobile partitions, flats and backdrops, plus a telescopic seating system, allow the space to adapt to meet a number of requirements, from theatrical performances and concerts, to sport events and corporate conventions. The structure also provides 1,600 sqm for collateral events or exhibition space, with air conditioning, a coat-checking service, parking for 5,000 cars, a bar and coffee shop, reserved access for the disabled, and a fitness centre with swimming pool.

4. Hotels

The organiser is providing more than one hotel in Genoa in order to get suitable, acceptable and reasonable prices for participants. Please note that all hotel reservations must be made through the organizing committee of the event.

Availability for 80 people will be reserved for us, the hostel is 9 Kms. from the “105 Stadium” sport hall and 3 Kms. from the city centre. Bus connections every hour to the city centre (bus line: 40 and 640). Note: highway exit Genova Ovest.



Should a team decide not to stay in the above official hotels, the organizing committee will charge 250 EUR per team for organizing costs such as arranging and preparing official hotels for the event, administrative and technical expenses etc. Moreover, such team will not take advantage of any organized services (transport etc.).

As some hotel availability is limited, the first teams that book and pay will have the opportunity to choose the hotels. JJEU Board and Committee Directors, responsible for the event, will stay in Sheraton Hotel.

Any extra officials (JJIF) should contact the organization.

5. How to get there

Reach Genoa by car:

You can reach Genoa easily by car, there are four different highways that connect it to the national highway network:

A7 - A10 - A12 - A26 / *Highway exit: Genova Ovest.*

Reach Genoa by plane:

The Cristoforo Colombo International Airport is the main airport serving Liguria. It offers regular connecting flights to major international airports. The Cristoforo Colombo International Airport is located in Sestri Ponente, which is six Kms. from the historic center of Genoa. Once at Genoa's Cristoforo Colombo airport you can easily reach the city center by shuttle bus AMT 100 Volabus that leaves every 30 minutes.

Sport Hall “105 Stadium” is situated in the Fiumara, a very large shopping mall located in Sampierdarena, a suburb to the west of the city center and only 1,5 Km. from “Cristoforo Colombo” Airport of Genoa. The distances from the hotels to the sport hall can be found in the last section. Nevertheless, transport will be arranged and teams should not worry about it. For any additional information you can contact us.



6. Transport

The organization has arranged transport from “Cristoforo Colombo” Airport of Genoa to official hotels, for all participants, who are staying in an official hotel, and also from hotels to the sport hall and, at the end, back to the airport.

Please, contact the organizers and provide them with exact information on your arrival and departure (means of transport, time and date of arrival, flight number etc.), so they can organize everything on time.

7. Right to participate and categories

- All competitors must be presented and registered by their National Federation.
- All competitors must have a legal passport and sports passport of their respective nation. Medical certificate is needed, not older than 12 months, certifying their fitness for competition.
- Maximum 2 participants or couples per category.
- An athlete is allowed to compete BOTH in Duo and Fighting for the same age category, but he/she is NOT allowed to be both junior and aspirant in the same tournament.
- ONLY 14 years-old athletes may participate to the Aspirants category. Therefore, only those born in 1998 can participate to the 1997-1995 category.
- An athlete may participate to the junior category but he/she will not be allowed to be both junior and aspirant in the same tournament.

8. Participants to the Assembly

Maximum two people per country may participate to the Assembly. However, only one (the National Delegate) will have the right of vote, provided that their Federation is up to date with its financial obligations with the JJIF/JJEU.

Each National Delegate must have a signed proxy from the National Federation.



9. Competition fees

Fighting system	60€/per competitor
Duo system	60€/per competitor

The amount must be paid to the O.C. at the moment of the official registration. Registration fee to the championship has been implemented and is applicable according to the new JJIF Financial Rules accepted by 2010/2011 General Assembly.

10. Judogi and protectors

All competitors must have and use judogi according to the JJIF/JJEU rules for official competition. Participants have to take their judogi to the registration desk at arrival. Soft hand and foot protections in proper colour; mouthpiece and jockstrap are required; chest protectors for female competitors are strongly recommended.

11. Advertsing

Please observe the regulations of the JJEU as far as advertising on the Judogi is concerned. Please note that during the championship no numbers on the back of the Judogi are allowed unless specified by the organizer. Numbers on the back of previous tournaments must be removed from the Judogi.

12. Competition Areas

5 competition areas will be prepared in the Sport-Hall and approved Tatami endorsed by J.J.I.F. will be used.



13. Referees

Each country should provide minimum 1 referee for up to 4 participants, 2 for up to 9 participants, and 3 for 10 or more. An amount of 800€ will be paid should a team not have the right number of referees indicated in the registration form. This rule doesn't apply to new members during the first 3 years. **Registration fee for not having referees at the championship will be paid according to the new JJIF Financial Rules accepted by 2010/2011 General Assembly.**

Referees should attend the official briefing meeting on Thursday afternoon.

Attention: only qualified referees from the JJEU/JJIF Referee Committee may participate as referees at the Championship. Information about qualified referees will be sent out by the Referee Committee. For more details see <http://www.jjif-referees.com> and www.jjif.info

Neither the organizing committee nor the JJEU/JJIF will be responsible for not respecting this obligation! However, if there won't be enough referees for the competition to take place in good conditions, JJEU Referee Committee may decide to complement the pool of referees with national referees of the organizing federation.

14. Rules and draw

- JJIF Competition Rules are provided on the official web sites of JJEU www.jjeu.eu or JJIF Referees Group web site <http://www.jjif-referees.com>).
- Competition organised by table with all participants getting a second chance.
- Computer program, approved by JJEU.
- Draw will be made by JJEU Sport Director and responsible official from the National Federation and JJEU Technical officers.
- The draw will be made Thursday 10th May 2012 at 22.00 for Friday, Saturday and Sunday and it is final!



- If a competitor will not have the correct weight at weighing - or the birth dates are not correct - he/she will stay in a pool/table but will automatically lose the match - no change will be made to the draw and no refund because of not fulfilling conditions for participant when already registered. There will be no second draw.
- General mistakes discovered at the draw can be corrected by JJEU officials (such as wrong name, person with similar names put in wrong categories etc.)
- Champions from the previous championship may not be in the same pool (if that is indicated at the draw);
- If by any chance in the second fights (repasage) the same fighters meet again, automatic change to the pool is done by the Head of Competition upon indication from the Head of the Mat.

15. Appeal Committee of the event

An appeal Committee of the event composed of 4 people from JJEU (3) and Italy (1) will be appointed by the JJEU Board.

Any member of the appeal committee is to be excluded from making any decisions if the participant involved is from the same country. An appeal fee of 200 EUR must be paid to the JJEU Treasurer before the appeal is filed (this amount will be returned if appeal is successful). Appeal must be filed immediately after the situation occurs (a verbal announcement and filed on paper) so the organizer may halt the competition to prevent appealed situation to continue. The decision of the appeal committee is final.

16. Antidoping Control

All members should warn their competitors that anti-doping controls will be carried out on several athletes in fighting or duo system.



17. Entrance

Tickets are free. Competitors, coaches and officials have free entry to the venues if properly accredited and registered (on all competition days).

18. Trophies

- At the end of the competition there will be a trophy for the best four countries.
- The first three athletes in each category receive a medal.
- A fair play trophy for both men and women categories (on proposals of referees and national coaches at the event).

19. Liability

Neither the organizers of the event, nor the National Federation (or any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for personal injury nor for any loss or damage to property arising from participation and travelling in connection with this championship.

Coaches and team leaders should make sure that all participants are physically fit, prepared and capable to cope with the championship.

20. Dress for Coaches

Coaches are invited to wear appropriate clothing while on the parterre. Therefore, access to the parterre will be forbidden to those who do not meet this requirement.

21. Flags and Anthems

Don't forget to check the flag and anthem of your country with the organizer when you arrive. We suggest you to bring your national anthem (short version) with you, to avoid any possible problem.
